- **C.** The period of the Fellowship shall be for **Two years** maximum.
- **D.** The award of SAF will be through presentation-cum-interview.

2. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- On the basis of the experts' assessment (if recommended), shortlisted candidates shall be required to make a presentation on their proposed subject of research.
- The award of the Fellowship will be decided by a Committee of subject experts, on the basis of the experts' evaluation of the proposal and the presentation made by the candidate.
- The presentation-cum-interview will be held at the ICHR's offices.
- Date & venue will be announced on the ICHR's website in due course of time.

3. Note:

The candidates who are selected to make presentation or appear for interviews will be reimbursed their travel charges to the extent of 3AC railway fare chargeable by the shortest routes from railway station nearest to their normal place of residence or from where they actually perform the journey on production of ticket(s).
